
Objectives:

The investment objective of the Davy Waterside Investment Fund 1 is to provide investors with capital appreciation. Davy Waterside Investment Fund 1 will seek to achieve its investment objective by acquiring, managing, developing and, potentially, realising the Property known as Waterside, located at Citywest Business Campus, Citywest, Dublin 24 (the Waterside Development) and any site(s) adjacent to the Waterside Development or other sites that, in the opinion of the Investment Manager and/or the Alternative Investment Fund Manager, is/are likely to enhance the value of the investment portfolio. Theremay alsobe investments in other assets including (but not limited to) Property Related Assets of bodies corporate investing in, owning, dealing in, developing or redeveloping any target property.

Intended Retail Investor:

The Product is targeted at Eligible Counterparties, Professional Clients and Retails Clients, provided they invest a minimum of €13,000,000. The investor's objective for this investment should be aligned with that of the Product as outlined above.
