### WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

This product is not subject to any fixed term.

#### Objectives:

The investment objective of the Davy Private Equity Strategies Fund 1 is to generate long term capital growth by investing primarily in a range of private equity type investments. J&E Davy as Investment Manager will principally aim to achieve private equity exposure by investing in a diversified portfolio of private equity Investment Funds giving due consideration to the quality of the underlying fund's investment management team, their strong long term track record and their diverse global investment activities. Such Investment Funds may include large buyout funds, venture capital funds, real estate funds, mezzanine funds and special situation funds. While the Investment Manager will generally seek exposure to private equity Investment Funds, the Investment Manager retains the discretion to vary the asset allocation due to market conditions or the availability of appropriate investment opportunities.

#### Intended Retail Investor:

The Product is targeted at Eligible Counterparties, Professional Clients and Retail Clients (only where retail clients meet the Irish Qualifying Investor criteria). The investor's objective for this investment should be aligned with that of the Product as outlined above.

### WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?



#### Risk indicator

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

**We have classified this product as class 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions could impact the capacity of the fund to pay you.**

**The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 10 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.**

**Be aware of currency risk.** You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.
