The Fund is managed by IQ EQ Fund Management (Ireland) Limited (the "Manager")

Objectives and Investment Policy

The investment objective of the Fund is to achieve long term capital growth. There is no guarantee or assurance that the investment objective of the Fund will actually be achieved.

The Fund aims to achieve this investment objective by investing in equities and equity linked securities (such as preferred shares and convertible bonds) of Chinese companies listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange via the Shanghai Hong Kong Stock Connect scheme, or the Shenzhen Stock Exchange via the Shenzhen Hong Kong Stock Connect scheme.

The Fund will primarily invest in onshore Chinese public equity markets. The Fund may invest in pooled real estate investment vehicles such as real estate investment trusts. The Fund may also invest in the units and/or shares of collective investment schemes, including exchange-traded funds ("ETFs") and money market funds, established as UCITS or alternative investment funds eligible for investment by a UCITS in accordance with the requirements of the Central Bank.

The Investment Manager generally seeks diversification rather than concentration by industry or sector when stocks are similarly valued.

For short-term cash management and defensive investment purposes, the Fund may invest in cash and/or investment grade Money Market Instruments with maturities up to one year.

The Fund's performance is compared to the MSCI China A Onshore Index (USD) Net (Ticker: MBCN1A) (the "Benchmark"). The Fund is actively managed and does not aim to replicate or track the Benchmark. The Benchmark represents the best approximation of the universe of securities in which the Fund may invest. The Fund's investment policy is not constrained and the degree of deviation from the Benchmark may be significant.





Classes A, B, C, and D shares do not pay a dividend. However Class A2, B2, C2 and D2 shares may pay a dividend on a semi-annual basis where substantially all net income relating to Class A2, B2, C2 and D2 shares shall be distributed.
